

# Hobby Paint Rack



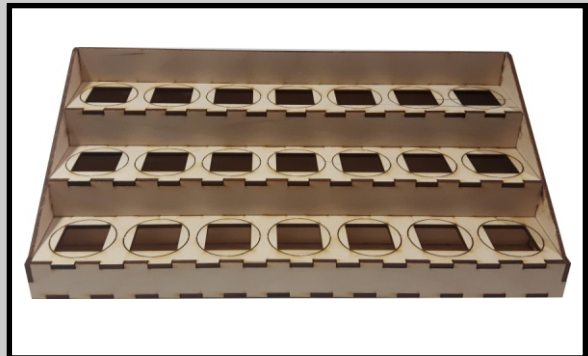
## Accessories Not Included Stand Measures

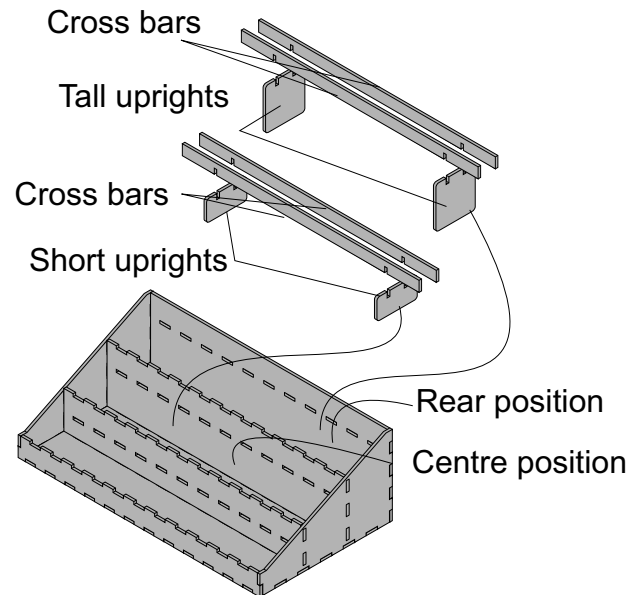
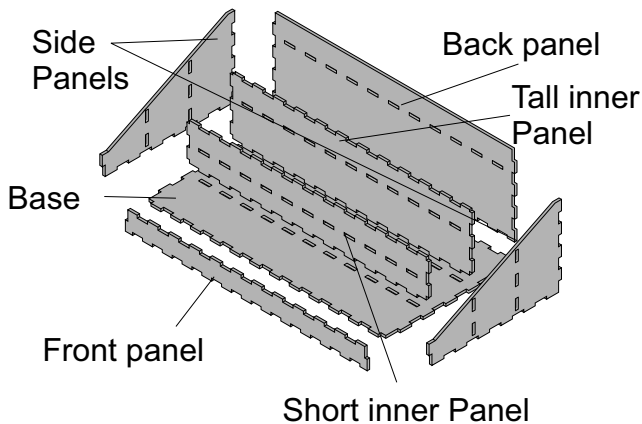

# Hobby Paint Rack

The Hobby Paint Rack is a great way to organize your paints and have them readily available for use. The rack holds 21 jars and by using the breakaway tab, can store jars up to 1 5/16". Remove the spacers and you can store other large items up to 1 5/8". Easily assembled in minutes using white glue and some masking tape (not included). If you like you can stain and seal it with urethane.

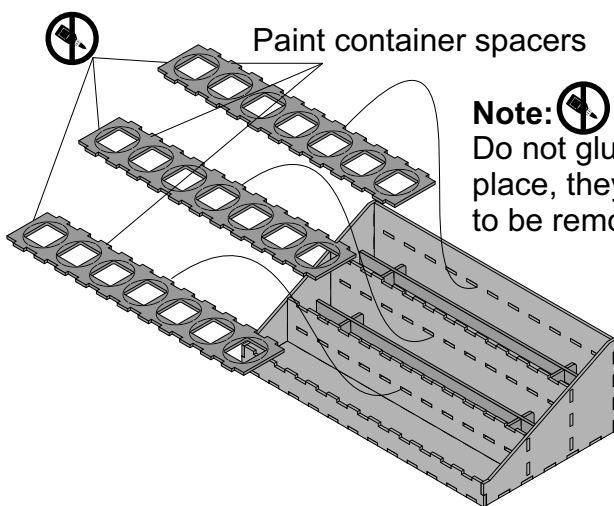
## Before you start

Regular white glue is used for construction. For best results dampen all joints with water, this helps the glue seep into the grain. Use masking tape to hold pieces together while glue dries. Build time approx 5 minutes.

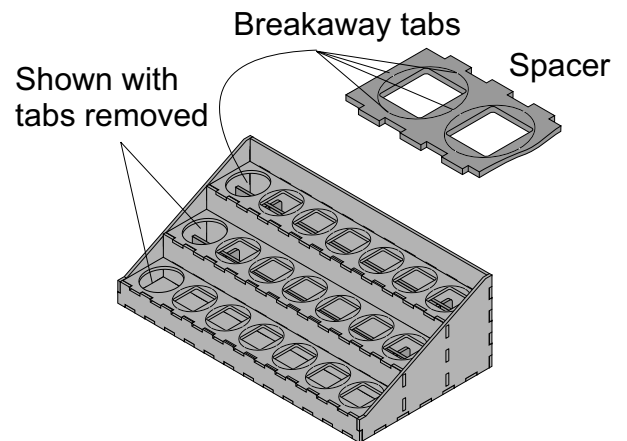


**1:** Place short and tall inner panels into the base first. Glue side panels into place followed by the back and front panels.

**2:** Place the cross bars into the uprights to make a set of short and tall shelves. Place tall shelf into the rear position and the short shelf into the centre position.



**3:** Place paint jar spacers into the slots on the back panels. Spacers are designed with a breakaway tab to allow for larger paint containers.



**4:** Once assembly is completed you may want to seal your work station using urethane or an epoxy resin.
